PORT HANDLING & LIFTING SUPERVISOR (Fixed Term Contract)

Position Objective

Responsible for overseeing the set-up, maintenance and safe and efficient operations of the port activities and lifting equipment. He/She is responsible for coordinating and supervising all lifting activities in accordance with regulations and is required to be present during all lifting operations.

Key Responsibilities

- Supervise the execution of port examination, release and loading duties for all port clerks in the port
- Responsible for ensuring that the port operations KPI are met
- Handling and Resolving all Customs Dispute that arise during customs examination
- Providing regular updates (at least 4 times daily) on port release status to the HOD
- Arranging transport with the pre-approved transporters and ensuring that truck inspections are carried out before cargo is loaded.
- Ensuring that port release and loading clerks meet their performance targets.
- Ensuring that EALS transport and delivery policy is adhered to always.
- Ensure that the tracking software is used for all cargo delivery.
- Ensuring that all original third-party receipts for delivered files are sent to Head office within 24 hours of cargo delivery
- Provide expertise in day to day handling and lifting activities on site, which include: categorizing lifts, hazard identifications and risk assessment, technical review (lifting procedures and organizations), selection of equipment/suitability of contractors' equipment, toolbox talk, post-job debriefing, and assessment of completed job
- Oversee pre-use inspections of forklifts, cranes and rigging equipment to be used in lifting operations
- Provide lifting and handling expertise advice
- Advise when possible on Security Concerns
- Develop and maintain up to date EALS handling and
