

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST: MONITORING EVOLVING SOCIAL DYNAMICS INCLUDING PROJECT INDUCED IN-MIGRATION (PIIM) FOR EACOP LTD IN TANZANIA. REFERENCE NO. REQ-00000826

East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) LTD, invites experienced and reputable companies or organizations to express their interest in Monitoring Evolving Social Dynamics Including Project Induced In-Migration (PIIM) For EACOP LTD in Tanzania.

The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of an underground and cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil from Lake Albert area in Uganda to eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale, Hoima District in Uganda to the Chongoleani peninsula in Tanga, Tanzania. The length of the pipeline is 1,443 km, of which 296 km will be in Uganda and 1,147 km in Tanzania. In Tanzania the pipeline will traverse eight (8) regions comprising of Kagera, Geita, Shinyanga, Tabora, Singida, Dodoma, Manyara and Tanga, 27 administrative District Councils, and 231 villages.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THE SERVICES:

Purpose:

EACOP Ltd seeks to engage a qualified and experienced service provider to conduct proactive and continuous monitoring of evolving social and demographic dynamics — including Project-Induced In-Migration (PIIM) — in selected communities in Tanzania impacted by the EACOP Project.

Objectives:

- · Monitor demographic changes in project-affected communities.
- · Assess socio-economic transformations and the project's impact on infrastructure, services, settlements, and livelihoods.
- Identify community responses, grievances, and emerging social tensions or conflict risks.
- Deliver actionable, evidence-based recommendations to help EACOP manage PIIM-related impacts effectively.

Scope & Approach:

- Conducting monthly field-based monitoring over a period of 12 months in selected villages along the pipeline Right of Way (RoW) and near Main Camps and Pipe Yards (MCPYs).
- Deploying a consistent enumerator to ensure data continuity and reliability.
- Engaging a diverse range of local informants including community leaders, service providers (education, health), women's groups, local business owners, in-migrants, and newly arrived groups (e.g., CSWs).
- Conducting structured observations during key times of social activity (e.g., late afternoons/evenings).
- Applying standardized tools including village transect walks, key informant interviews, and 360-degree photo documentation.
- Providing comprehensive reports integrating both quantitative and qualitative insights.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Companies or Organizations expressing their interest are invited to document their request with:

- Brief description of experience, expertise, and capacity to deliver the required scope of services.
- Details of similar projects or activities undertaken, along with evidence of previous contracts of similar scope including reference letters
 or completion certificates from at least three (3) reputable clients within the past five years.
- Profiles of key personnel proposed for this engagement, including their qualifications, relevant experience and track record of the above-listed
 experience and any applicable certifications.
- Company profile including an organizational structure.
- Valid Business License.
- · Certificate of Incorporation.
- A copy of the most recent official search report from the Business Registrations and Licensing Agency (BRELA).
- Valid Tax Identification Number (TIN) and Tax Clearance Certificate for the year 2025.
- · Evidence of appropriate sector-specific licenses or permits, if required, from relevant regulatory authorities in Tanzania.
- Proof of Registration with the EWURA Local Supplier Service Provider (LSSP) database or an approved application at the time of submission of the response to this expression of interest is strongly recommended.
- Demonstrated compliance with the Local Content Regulations, 2017, and confirmation of status as a Local Company.
- · Audited financial statements for the past three (3) years demonstrating financial capacity to execute the services.
- Proof of relevant registration/certification with HSE regulatory and certifying bodies.
- Evidence of a QHSE management system, organization and process in compliance with applicable local and industry standards for similar works.
- · Proof of Anti-corruption, Anti-bribery, Compliance and Human Rights policies.
