

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST: PROVISION OF CALIBRATION AND CERTIFICATION SERVICES FOR PRESSURE SAFETY VALVES (PSV) - UGANDA (RE-ADVERTISED) REFERENCE NO. 00000850

East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) LTD ("EACOP LTD") invites suitably qualified, experienced and reputable companies, organizations or joint ventures to express their interest in the provision of Calibration and Certification Services to Pressure Safety Valves (PSV) for East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) Project.

The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of a buried and cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil from Lake Albert area in Uganda to eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale, Hoima District in Uganda to the Chongoleani peninsula in Tanga, Tanzania. The length of the pipeline is 1,443 km, of which 296km will be in Uganda and 1,147 km in Tanzania. In Uganda the pipeline will traverse ten districts and in Tanzania, eight (8) regions comprising of Kagera. Geita, Shinyanga, Tabora, Singida, Dodoma, Manyara and Tanga, 27 administrative District Councils, and 231 Villages.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THE SERVICES

The EACOP is equipped with Pressure Safety Valves (PSVs) to prevent overpressure, potential hazards and ensure system integrity. This Expression of Interest (EOI) seeks to identify qualified candidates capable of providing calibration and certification services for Pressure Safety Valves installed on the Uganda side of the EACOP project.

Services required include, but not limited to:

- Calibration and Certification of approximately 28 Pressure Safety Valves (PSVs)
- Stamping and documentation in accordance with relevant Authority requirements.

NB: The calibration and certification services must be performed in accordance with the respective equipment manufacturer's specifications, applicable international & industrial standards and full compliance with the regulatory requirements.

The sites in Uganda which will be installed with PSVs include:

- PS1 Hoima District
- PS2 Sembabule District

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Companies or Organization/local joint ventures expressing their interest are invited to submit documentation of their request with:

- Brief description of experience, expertise and capacity to deliver the required scope of services.
- Proof of certified, qualified personnel/manpower who will be responsible for performing Calibration and Certification services.
- Valid Business License

- Proof of registration with the Uganda Registration Services Bureau (URSB) including Beneficial Owners Particulars.
- Certificate of Incorporation and recent Uganda Registration Services Bureau (URSB) search (attach copy).
- Proof of registration on the National Supplier database maintained by the Petroleum Authority of Uganda.
- Compliance with the Petroleum (Refining, Conversion, Transmission and Midstream storage) (National Content) Regulations, 2016
- Proof of registration with Uganda Revenue Authority (URA) and valid Tax Clearance Certificate.
- Bank confirmation letter of financial capacity, including the submission of financial accounts audited for the past three years.
- Evidence of Quality, Health, Safety, and Environment (QHSE) management system compliant with local and industry standards.
- Proof of Anti-corruption, Anti-bribery, Compliance and Human Rights policies.

All Expression of Interests should be submitted in English Language.

Only the pre-qualified companies, organizations or local Joint ventures will, after signing a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA), receive an invitation to bid as a continuation of the call for tender process.
