



**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST: PIG SUPPLY
AND PROVISION OF SUPPORT SERVICES – UGANDA &
TANZANIA (CROSS-BORDER) REFERENCE NO.00000908
(RE-ADVERTISED)**

IMPORTANT NOTICE: This EOI replaces and supersedes the previously 2025 advertised country-specific EOIs (Ref: REQ-00000908 for Tanzania and REQ-00000909 for Uganda). Due to a technical revision in the EACOP project execution strategy, the scope is now consolidated into a single, cross-border requirement. Applicants must demonstrate capability to deliver services seamlessly across the entire Uganda–Tanzania EACOP pipeline corridor.

East African Crude Oil Pipeline [EACOP] LTD (“EACOP LTD”) invites experienced and reputable International/Local companies or qualified joint ventures to express their interest in the provision of Pig Supply and Support Services for the operational phase of the EACOP Project.

The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of a buried and cross-border 24 inches pipeline to transport crude oil from Lake Albert area in Uganda to eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale, Hoima District in Uganda to the Chongoleani peninsula in Tanga, Tanzania. The length of the pipeline is 1,443 km, of which 296km will be in Uganda and 1,147 km in Tanzania. In Uganda the pipeline has 2 pumping stations along its length. In Tanzania, the pipeline has 4 pumping stations and 2 pressure reduction stations along its length before terminating in a Marine Terminal at Tanga.

Pigging activities will be performed across the full EACOP pipeline corridor and must ensure operational continuity from Uganda to Tanzania.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE (SPECIFICATIONS)

EACOP LTD seeks to identify qualified pigging service providers capable of:

1. Supplying all required pigging products for the entire cross-border EACOP pipeline system and
2. Providing local technical support, refurbishment, maintenance and operational services in both Uganda and Tanzania.

The selected entity must demonstrate integrated cross-border operational capability.

Mandatory Cross-Border Requirement: Applicants MUST demonstrate either:

- Legal registration and operational presence in both Uganda and Tanzania OR
- Formal Declaration of Intent to form a Joint Venture/Consortium clearly defined country-specific scope and responsibilities.

Failure to demonstrate compliant cross-border capability will result in disqualification.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

During the start-up and operations phase of the EACOP asset, Pigging operations are required to ensure pipeline integrity and flow assurance, including: Removal of wax deposits, Removal of debris and foreign materials, Removal of accumulated water, Support during start-up and steady-state operations. Services are divided into two main components:

A. PIG PRODUCT SUPPLY (24-inch)

Supply of pigging equipment for use across the Uganda–Tanzania EACOP pipeline corridor, including:

- **Pigs type required:** Bi-directional (Bi-Di) pigs and Foam pigs
- **Bi-Di pigs** must include replaceable components such as: Polyurethane guide discs, Seal discs, Spacer discs, Tracker, Bumper nose, Jet function (where required), Brushes and magnets.
- **Pigging Poles:** Supply of poles to facilitate pig launching and retrieval from barrels.
- **Delivery Points:** PS1 Kabaale (Uganda) and Marine Storage Terminal (MST) Warehouse, Tanga (Tanzania).

The pig products supply is expected to be executed by main company expressing interest.

B. PIGGING SUPPORT SERVICES

The service provider shall provide, in both countries Uganda & Tanzania:

- **Accessories Procurement & Stock Management:** Maintain local stock of pig accessories to enable rapid refurbishment.
- **Used Pig Re-Evaluation:** Collect and inspect used pigs following each run to determine: Re-use, Refurbishment & Scrapping.

- **Refurbishment:** Replace damaged components locally and return pigs to operational readiness.
- **Scrapping & Disposal:** Dispose of irreparable pigs in accordance with EACOP H3SE requirements.
- **Technical Support:** Provide on-call technical support for; Stuck pig scenarios, Abnormal pigging events, Troubleshooting and diagnostics.
- **Training:** Deliver On-site operational training, Refresher training & Technical advisory sessions.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Interested International/Local companies or joint ventures expressing their interest must provide:

1. Brief description of experience, expertise, and capacity to deliver the required scope of services.
 - Minimum five (5) years’ proven experience in pig manufacturing, pigging support services or both.
 - Demonstrated experience on cross-border or long-distance pipeline systems.
 - Evidence of similar projects undertaken in oil & gas operations.
 - Availability of qualified engineering and technical personnel.
2. Valid regulatory licenses in both countries; (attach copy).
 - Tanzania: Valid Business License; Certificate of Incorporation and BRELA search; Registration with EWURA Local Supplier Service Provider (LSSP) database (or evidence of application) is strongly recommended; TRA registration and valid Tax Clearance; Compliance with Local Content Regulations (2017).
 - Uganda: Valid Business License; Certificate of Incorporation & Ownership documents; Proof of Registration on the National Supplier Database (NSD) maintained by the Petroleum Authority of Uganda; Valid Uganda Revenue Authority registration and Tax Clearance; Statement of Compliance with the Petroleum (Refining, Conversion, Transmission and midstream storage) - National Content Regulations (2016).
 - For Joint Ventures: Formal Declaration of Intent to form a Joint Venture/ Consortium clearly defining country-specific scope & responsibilities.
3. Financial capacity to deliver the services required including submission of Audited financial statements for the last three (3) years and a Bank reference letter demonstrating financial strength to support operational continuity.
4. Evidence of a Quality, Health, Safety and Environment (QHSE) Management system, organization and process in compliance with applicable Local and Industry standards for similar works.
5. Proof of Anti-corruption, Anti-bribery, Human Rights and Compliance policies.

Statements of EOI should be no more than ten (10) to twenty (20) pages long. All Expression of Interests should be submitted in the English language.

NOTE: EACOP LTD will review and assess the documents provided by companies that have expressed interest in accordance with this EOI and conduct evaluations based on internal criteria to determine which companies or local Joint ventures will be included in the list of pre-qualified companies or local Joint ventures. Only the pre-qualified companies or local Joint ventures will receive, by signing a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA), an invitation to bid as a continuation of the call for tender process. EACOP LTD reserves the right at its sole discretion to make the decision to select or reject a company or local Joint ventures and maintain its decision without having to give reasons to the company or local Joint ventures concerned.
