REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST: PROVISION OF GENERAL MAINTENANCE CAMPAIGN SERVICES FOR EACOP - UGANDA. REFERENCE NO. REQ-00001100

East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP LTD) invites suitably qualified, experienced and reputable companies, organizations or local joint ventures to express their interest in the provision of **General Maintenance Campaign Services** for EACOP LTD within Uganda.

The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of a buried, cross-border 24-inch heated pipeline to transport crude oil from Lake Albert area in Uganda to the eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline spans 1,443 km, comprising of 296 km in Uganda and 1,147 km in Tanzania. In Uganda, the pipeline traverses ten (10) districts: Hoima, Kikuube, Kakumiro, Kyankwanzi, Mubende, Gomba, Lwengo, Sembabule, Rakai, and Kyotera. In Tanzania, it traverses eight (8) regions: Kagera, Geita, Shinyanga, Tabora, Singida, Dodoma, Manyara, and Tanganyika.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF SERVICES:

As a General Maintenance Campaign Services provider, you will supply skilled personnel to deliver Level 1, 2, and 3 maintenances across EACOP installations along the 296 km Uganda pipeline from Hoima to Kyotera. The scope covers 23 Mainline Block Valves (MLBVs) and two Pumping Stations (PS1 and PS2), with only PS1 at Kabaale being permanently manned-requiring most maintenance to be executed in campaign mode.

This Expression of Interest (EOI) invites qualified companies, organizations, or local joint ventures to provide General Maintenance Campaign Services for EACOP Ltd in Uganda.

Manned Site (Kabaale, Hoima District):

Permanent deployment of personnel to perform routine maintenance and support EACOP's Maintenance Team.

- **Manpower:** Minimum of 4 technicians
- **Skills:** Multi-disciplinary expertise in Electrical, Mechanical, Instrumentation, and Telecommunications

Unmanned Sites (Campaign Mode):

Provision of maintenance manpower and full logistics support, including transport, accommodation, meals, water, medical support, and sanitation.

- **Manpower:** Minimum of 3 technicians and 1 supervisor
- **Skills:** Multi-disciplinary expertise in Electrical, Mechanical, Instrumentation, and Telecommunications
- **Locations:** 10 districts -Hoima, Kikuube, Kakumiro, Kyankwanzi, Mubende, Gomba, Sembabule, Lwengo, Kyotera, and Rakai.

Note: During the Call for Tender (CFT), the scope will be divided into two lots based on maintenance mode and pipeline operational areas:

- LOT 1:** Maintenance campaign for the 23 MLBVs in Uganda
- LOT 2:** Onsite and campaign maintenance for PS1 and PS2

EACOP may, at its discretion, award a single contract covering all lots or separate contracts for individual lots. Level 1–3 maintenance works include non-intrusive tests,

visual inspections of electrical, mechanical, and hydraulic equipment; like for like replacement of equipment; lubrication; minor adjustments and calibrations; replacement of small parts (belts, bolts, couplings, gaskets, seals, etc.); replacement of valves and pressure/temperature gauges; cleaning of units (cabinets, solar panels, LV UPS, etc.); minor-to-medium repairs; and measurements.

Equipment overhauls are excluded, and general maintenance campaigns are strictly limited to like for like replacements.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Companies, organizations, or local joint ventures are invited to submit the following in support of their Expression of Interest:

- Summary of relevant experience, expertise, and service delivery capacity
- List of certified personnel with roles, qualifications, and experience
- Valid Trading License
- Certificate of Incorporation/Registration and recent URSB search
- Certified copy of Form 20 or Form 24 (as applicable)
- Evidence of registration on the PAU National Supplier Database
- Statement of compliance with the Petroleum National Content Regulations, 2016
- URA registration and valid Tax Clearance Certificate
- Proof of financial capacity, including audited accounts for the last three years
- Evidence of a QHSE management system compliant with industry and local standards
- Policies on anti-corruption, anti-bribery, compliance, and human rights

Companies, organizations, or local joint ventures with the required capacity are invited to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) by email, including the listed documents, to procurement.ug@eacop.com (maximum size 20 MB) no later than 17:00 EAT on 27th May 2026. EOI submissions must not exceed 20 pages and shall be submitted in English.

NOTE: EACOP LTD will review and assess the documents provided by companies, organizations or local joint ventures that have expressed interest in accordance with this EOI, and conduct evaluations based on internal criteria to determine which companies, organizations or local joint ventures will be included in the list of pre-qualified companies, organizations or local joint ventures. Only the pre-qualified companies, organizations or local joint ventures will, after signing a Non-Disclosure Agreement, receive an invitation to bid as a continuation of the Call for Tender process. EACOP LTD reserves the right at its sole discretion to make the decision to select or reject a company, organization or local joint venture and maintain its decision without having to give reasons to the company, organization or local joint venture concerned.
