

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST: MEDICAL INSURANCE SERVICES REFERENCE NO. REQ-00001102

East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) Ltd, is mandated with the construction and operation of a buried, cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil from the Lake Albert area in Uganda to the eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale in Hoima District, Uganda, to Chongoleani, Tanga Region, in Tanzania. It shall be 1,443 kilometres (km) long, of which 296 km will be in Uganda occupying a 30-meter-wide corridor.

The company plans on engaging a reputable insurance services provider to provide medical insurance cover to EACOP Staff based in Tanzania. East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) Ltd invites experienced and reputable service providers to express their interest in providing Medical Insurance Cover for its staff.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THE SERVICES:

- The Company is inviting eligible and reputable insurance providers with adequate experience and expertise to design, underwrite, and administer a comprehensive medical insurance program for EACOP staff and their eligible dependents in Tanzania, ensuring high-quality, accessible, and cost-effective healthcare, as well as efficient digital monitoring and reporting in alignment of all services with EACOP internal policies and procedures (including Fit to Work Procedure).

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION:

- **Tanzania:** Dar es Salaam, Tanga, Dodoma, Singida, Tabora, Shinyanga, Mwanza, Kahama, Bukoba, Muleba, and any additional locations.
- **Uganda:** Kampala, Hoima, Ssembabule Kikuube, Kakumiro, Kyankwanzi, Mubende, Gomba, Lwengo, Kyotera, Rakai and any additional locations.
- **International Coverage:** As specified by the Company, including referral countries (e.g., Kenya, South Africa, India) for specialized treatment and emergency evacuation.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Service providers expressing their interest are requested to submit the following minimum documents:

- Copy of current Business Licence.
- Copy of certificate of Registration or incorporation.
- Valid current Tax Clearance Certificate.
- Registration and licensed with Insurance Regulatory Authority as Insurance Providers.
- Audited financial reports for the previous three years.
- Proof of ability to provide an electronic system or an application (software) to monitor utilization. Evidence of providing similar services to corporates in Tanzania for the past five years. This can be in the form of two letters from current client.
- List of experienced, competent, and qualified affiliated hospitals, clinics, pharmacies, and laboratories across the operations areas of the Company.
- Proof of registration with the Tanzania Revenue Authority (TRA).
- Brief description of experience, expertise, and capacity to deliver required scope of services.
- Proof of registration with the EWURA Local Supplier Service Provider (LSSP) database or an approved application at the time of submission of the response to this expression of interest is strongly recommended.
- Compliance with Petroleum Local Content Regulations in Tanzania/ Local Company definition.
