



REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST: PROVISION OF GENERAL MAINTENANCE CAMPAIGN SERVICES FOR EACOP - TANZANIA REFERENCE NO. REQ-00001097

East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) Ltd invites suitably qualified, experienced and reputable companies, organizations or local joint ventures to express their interest in the provision of General Maintenance Campaign Services for EACOP Ltd within Tanzania.

The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of a buried, cross-border 24-inch heated pipeline to transport crude oil from Lake Albert area in Uganda to eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline spans 1,443 km, comprising of 296 km in Uganda and 1,147 km in Tanzania. In Uganda, the pipeline traverses ten (10) districts: Hoima, Kikuube, Kakumiro, Kyankwanzi, Mubende, Gomba, Lwengo, Sembabule, Rakai, and Kyotera. In Tanzania, it traverses eight (8) regions: Kagera, Geita, Shinyanga, Tabora, Singida, Dodoma, Manyara, and Tanga.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THE SERVICES:

As a service provider, you will provide skilled personnel to perform Level 1–3 general maintenance on EACOP installations along the Tanzania pipeline corridor from Kagera to Tanga Region. The scope covers: 53 Mainline Block Valves (MLBVs), four (4) Pumping Stations (PS3–PS6), two (2) Pressure Reduction Stations (PRS1–PRS2), and the Marine Tanks & Terminal (MTT) in Tanga. Except for PS4, PS5 and MTT, all sites are unmanned, remote and widely dispersed, requiring campaign based maintenance. This Expression of Interest (EOI) invites qualified companies, organizations or local joint ventures to provide general maintenance campaign services for EACOP Ltd in Tanzania.

Categorized as follows:

1. Manned Sites: Deployment of permanently stationed personnel to execute routine maintenance and support EACOP Maintenance Teams.

- **Manpower:** Minimum 16 technicians.
- **Competency:** Electrical, Mechanical, Instrumentation and Telecommunications.
- **Locations:** Geita, Tabora, Tanga.

2. Unmanned Sites: Campaign based execution of maintenance activities, inclusive of full logistics support (transport, accommodation, meals, potable water, medical support, mobile sanitation and related services).

- **Manpower:** Minimum 20 technicians and 5 supervisors.
- **Competency:** Electrical, Mechanical, Instrumentation and Telecommunications.
- **Deployment Locations:** Kagera, Geita, Shinyanga, Tabora, Singida, Manyara, Dodoma, Tanga.

At Call for Tender (CFT) stage, services shall be divided into four (4) LOTS:

- **LOT 1:** Maintenance Campaign – 53 MLBVs.
- **LOT 2:** Onsite & Campaign Maintenance – PS3 & PS4.
- **LOT 3:** Onsite & Campaign Maintenance – PS5 & PS6.
- **LOT 4:** Onsite & Campaign Maintenance – PRS1, PRS2, MTT and Load Out Facility (LOF).

Note: EACOP may award a single contract for all LOTS or separate contracts per LOT.

3. Maintenance Scope (Level 1–3) includes: non intrusive testing, visual inspections, lubrication, minor adjustments and calibrations, like for like replacement of equipment and components (valves, gauges, belts, bolts, seals, gaskets, couplings), cleaning of systems (cabinets, solar panels, LV UPS), measurements, and minor to medium repairs. Major overhauls are excluded. Maintenance campaigns are strictly limited to like for like replacement.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Companies, organization, or local joint ventures expressing their interest are invited to submit documentation of their request with:

- Brief description of experience, expertise, and capacity to deliver the required scope of services.
- A list of certified personnel/manpower who will be responsible to perform the services with indication of their experiences and qualifications.
- Valid Business License.
- Proof of registration with Tanzania Bureau of Standards (TBS).
- Certificate of Incorporation and recent Business Registration and Licensing Agency (BRELA) search (attach copy).
- Proof of Registration with the Energy and Water Utilities Regulatory Authority (EWURA) as a Local Supplier Service Provider (LSSP) database or a copy of an approved application at the time of submission of the response to this Expression of Interest is strongly recommended.
- Compliance with Local Content Regulations, 2017 and Local Company definition.
- Proof of registration with Tanzania Revenue Authority (TRA) and valid Tax Clearance Certificate.
- Financial capacity evidence including financial accounts for the last three years.
- Evidence of Quality, Health, Safety, and Environment (QHSE) management system compliant with local and industry standards.
- Proof of Anti-corruption, Anti-bribery, Compliance and Human Rights policies.

Companies, organizations or local joint ventures which have the ability, capacity, and resources to implement the activities listed above should express their interest by sending an Expression of Interest (EOI) via email, together with the above listed documents through an email to procurement.tz@eacop.com (max. email size 20MB) on or before **17:00** hours East African Time (EAT), on **28th May 2026**.

Statements of EOI should be no more than twenty (20) pages long. **All Expression of Interests should be submitted in the English Language.**

Note: EACOP Ltd will review and assess the documents provided by companies, organizations or local joint ventures that have expressed interest in accordance with this EOI, and conduct evaluations based on internal criteria to determine which companies, organizations or local joint ventures will be included in the list of pre-qualified companies, organizations or local joint ventures. Only the pre-qualified companies, organizations or local joint ventures will, after signing a Non-Disclosure Agreement, receive an invitation to bid as a continuation of the Call for Tender process. EACOP Ltd reserves the right at its sole discretion to make the decision to select or reject a company, organization or local joint venture and maintain its decision without having to give reasons to the company, organization or local joint venture concerned.
