



East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) Ltd invites experienced and reputable companies or organizations to express their interest in the Supply Bulk Diesel Fuel Supply for Standby and Prime Power Generatorsto the EACOP Project during the phase in Tanzania.

Project Overview: The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of a buried and cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil from Lake Albert area in Uganda to eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale, Hoima District in Uganda to the Chongoleani peninsula in Tanga, Tanzania. The length of the pipeline is 1,443 km, of which 296km will be in Uganda and 1,147 km in Tanzania. In Uganda the pipeline will traverse two (2) regions which are Western and Central regions and in Tanzania, eight (8) regions comprising of Kagera, Geita, Shinyanga, Tabora, Singida, Dodoma, Manyara and Tanga, 27 administrative District Councils, and 231 Villages.

SCOPE OF SERVICE:

This Expression of Interest (EOI) seeks to identify qualified and capable suppliers who will provide Bulk Diesel Fuel Supply for Standby and Prime Power Generators meeting the local regulatory standards and EACOP quality specifications for the safe and efficient Operations phase of the EACOP pipeline project.

Services required include, but not limited to:

1 Product Specification:

Automotive Gas Oil (AGO) conforming to local regulatory standards and EACOP quality requirements, including:

- Sulphur content ≤ 50 ppm (Euro 4/5 compliant)
- Cetane Number ≥ 51
- Density at 15°C: 820–845 kg/m³
- Climate-appropriate cloud points
- Free from contamination (water, sediments, microbial growth)
- Certified batch test results from accredited laboratories

2 Supply Volumes:

- Peak consumption per week Estimated to be 2,000,000 LTRS at each manned stations PS4, PS 5 & MTT
- Flexible volumes based on operational demands from XX to 2,000,000ltrs

3 Delivery Requirements:

Fleet Capacity & Age Requirements

- Minimum fleet size aligned with demand profile (e.g., ability to deliver to PS3–PS6, PRS, MTT simultaneously)
- Tanker truck capacity mix (e.g. 20,000L – 45,000L per unit) to ensure flexibility across sites
- All delivery truck tankers must be ≤ 5 years old
- Fire suppression systems
- Drivers must be Certified for hazardous material transport
- Drivers must possess Defensive driving certification
- Bulk supply via ADR-compliant road tankers with calibrated meters and seals
- 24/7 delivery capability including emergency supply arrangements
- Supplier to maintain strategic stockholdings to ensure continuous operations

Storage Capacity & Supply Continuity

- Secondary / Backup Storage -long term Agreements with third-party terminals
- Minimum storage capacity: Sufficient to cover 7–14 days of EACOP demand
- Strategic locations: Dar es Salaam (import hub) & Tanga (critical for MTT & PRS 1 supply)
- Emergency Readiness

Key Locations – Mobile refuelling services at remote operational sites include:

- Pumping Stations: PS3 (Muleba/Kagera), PS4 (Mbogwe/Geita), PS5 (Iungu/Tabora), PS6 (Singida/Singida).
- Pressure Reduction Stations: PRS1 (Kiteto/Manyara), PRS2 (Handeni/Tanga).
- Marine Terminal and LOF (Tanga Region).

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Companies or Organization/local joint ventures expressing their interest are invited to submit documentation of their request with:

- Brief description of minimum 5 years' experience, expertise, and capacity to deliver the required scope of large-scale fuel supply.
- Details of similar projects or activities undertaken/ provide evidence of previous contracts with major industrial or oil & gas clients.
- Valid Business License for trading petroleum products in Tanzania.
- Certificate of Incorporation and recent BRELA search report (attach current copy).
- Proof of Registration with the EWURA Local Supplier Service Provider (LSSP) database or a copy of an approved application at the time of submission of the response to this expression of interest is strongly recommended.
- Compliance with Local Content Regulations, 2017 and 100% owned by Tanzanians.
- Proof of registration with the Tanzania Revenue Authority (TRA) and Tax Clearance Certificate.
- Financial capacity to deliver the service with a bank confirmation letter including audited financial accounts for the last three years .Company must demonstrate strong financial capacity to sustain uninterrupted supply , Annual turnover $\geq 2-3x$ contract value. Strong liquidity position:
- Evidence of Quality, Health, Safety, and Environment (QHSE) management system compliant with local and industry standards. Relevant Registration/Certification with HSE regulatory bodies and Appropriate Licensing from relevant authorities.
- Evidence of Quality, Health, Safety, and Environment (QHSE) management system compliant with local and industry standards, supported by relevant certifications, licenses, and procedures to ensure EACOP HSE compliant including Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) provision, product traceability form depot to delivery site, certified and trained tanker drivers for hazardous fuel transport, spill prevention and emergency response plans, and regular equipment inspection and maintenance.
- Proof of Anti-corruption, Anti-bribery, Compliance and Human Rights policies.
