

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST: CONSTRUCTION OF SCHOOL FACILITIES FOR VULNERABLE ETHNIC GROUPS SELF-IDENTIFYING AS INDIGENOUS PEOPLES (VEGIPS) COMMUNITIES REFERENCE NO. REQ-00001181

East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) Ltd invites suitably qualified and experienced Tanzanian companies to express interest in the construction of school facilities (Primary school classrooms, staff houses, student dormitories and sanitation facilities as part of Community Benefit Project for Vulnerable Ethnic Groups self-identifying as Indigenous Peoples in Hanang District, Manyara Region.

The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of an underground, cross-border pipeline for the transportation of crude oil from the Lake Albert area in Uganda to the eastern coast of Tanzania for export to international markets. In Tanzania, the pipeline extends to the Chongoleani Peninsula in Tanga Region and has an approximate length of 1,147 km.

Within Tanzania, the pipeline traverses eight (8) regions, namely Kagera, Geita, Shinyanga, Tabora, Singida, Dodoma, Manyara, and Tanga.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE WORKS:

- The works comprise the construction of education infrastructure under a Community Benefit Project in Gorimba Village and Diloda Village, Lalaji Ward, Hanang District, Manyara Region, in accordance with the applicable laws of the United Republic of Tanzania, approved designs and specifications, and relevant guidance issued by the Ministry responsible for education.
- The objective of the assignment is to improve access to safe, inclusive, and adequate learning infrastructure for beneficiary communities in remote and underserved areas.
- The anticipated scope at each school includes the construction of four (4) classrooms, one (1) staff house, and sanitation facilities comprising six (6) latrine drop holes, and two student dormitories together with all associated civil, structural, architectural, mechanical, electrical, drainage, and external works required for complete and operational handover.
- The successful contractor shall be responsible for the full execution of the works, including mobilization, site establishment, site preparation, foundations, superstructure, roofing, finishes, plumbing and sanitation installations, electrical installations where applicable, testing, commissioning, rectification of defects, and demobilization, in accordance with the contract requirements and Good International Industry Practice.
- All materials incorporated into the works shall be new, fit for purpose, durable, and compliant with applicable Tanzania Bureau of Standards requirements, national building regulations, and approved technical specifications. The contractor shall also demonstrate the capacity to implement the works in a manner that protects community health and safety, safeguards children and other vulnerable persons, and complies with applicable environmental, social, labour, anti-bribery, and human rights requirements.
- EACOP is seeking a reputable company with demonstrated track record of undertaking the construction of school facilities in rural areas in accordance with the Tanzania standards and good international industry practice.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

Companies expressing their interest are invited to document their request with:

- Details of relevant experience in construction of school facilities in Tanga, Manyara, and Dodoma.
- Details of the ability to perform all works. Interested companies can enter into an agreement with other companies to enhance their service offering, however, all and each partner in the agreement MUST meet the COMPANY requirements.
- Proof of registration with relevant Tanzanian Registration Bodies (current BRELA search).
- Tanzanian National Contractors (Building) Registration minimum Class VII (submit copy).
- Proof of registration with the Tanzania Revenue Authority and Tax (TRA) Clearance Certificate for the latest year available.
- Registration with EWURA Local Supplier Service Provider (LSSP) database or an accepted application for registration at the time of submission of the response to this expression of interest is required.
- Compliance with Local Content Regulations, 2017 and Local Company definition.
- Financial capacity to deliver the services required including submission of financial accounts for year.
- Provide/demonstrate HSE (OSHA), Social and Quality Assurance and Control policies.
- Provide/demonstrate experience with project management techniques and controls, as well as large scale logistics and procurement capabilities.
- Evidence of a QHSE Management system, organization, and process in compliance with applicable Local and Industry standards for similar works.
- Proof of Anti-corruption, Anti-bribery, Compliance and Human Rights policies.
