Purpose and scope of assignment

Marine Mammal Observers (MMO) shall actively assist the operation team at construction site in monitoring and reporting the sightings of cetaceans and take positive action to avoid any interference or negative interaction with these animals

- Define the exclusion and buffer zones in accordance with Company procedures
- Perform observation in accordance with JNCC guidelines and Company requirements and Procedures.
- Perform visual or acoustic detection, assess animal behavior and directly report to the piling superintendent and marine construction manager and recommend whether can start, delay or stop work.
- Preparation of Daily, Weekly, and Monthly Reports detailing all observations / acoustic detections of Marine Fauna in accordance with JNCC guidelines.
- Advise the operation team on the action to be taken when there's sightings of concerned marine mammal.
- Advise the Construction Manager on the best location to perform the marine fauna observation.
- Communicate any issues related to concerned marine mammal to the H3SE Manager.
- Monitor and record Marine Mammal activity during the course piling activity.
- Monitor and record activity of other species of concern identified by the project environmental impact assessment.
- Ensure all onboard procedures in relation to Marine Mammals conform to expectations set out.
- Compiling and reporting after each monitoring activities.
- Work with operation team and vessel crew as a team.

- Experienced in monitoring marine mammals.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills with multicultural team.
