# REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST: CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR ASSESSMENT AND COMPENSATION FOR UNVIABLE RESIDUAL LAND REQ-00000646

East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) LTD (“COMPANY”) invites experienced and reputable Companies to express their interest in the Provision of Consultancy Services for Assessment and Compensation for Unviable Residual Land to the East African Crude Oil Pipeline (EACOP) Project. The EACOP Project involves the construction and operation of an underground and cross-border pipeline to transport crude oil for export to international markets. The pipeline will run from Kabaale, Hoima District in Uganda to the Chongoleani peninsula, Tanga Region, in Tanzania. The length of the pipeline is 1,443 km, of which 296 km will be in Uganda.

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THE SERVICES:

As a result of the implementation of the Resettlement Action Plan (RAP), some of the Project Affected Persons’ (PAPs) retained residual land that cannot be sustainably utilised hence a reduction in respective economic values. COMPANY invites suitably qualified companies to express interest in the provision of Consultancy Services for the assessment and compensation for the unviable residual land.

Services will include:

- Project planning, reconnaissance surveys and preparation of an inception report
- Stakeholder Engagement and community sensitization
- Legal Due Diligence and verification of the land ownership
- Obtaining consent to assess and compensate unviable residual land
- Asset and Cadastral Surveys for unviable residual land
- Preparation of a valuation report
- Preparation and execution of compensation agreements
- Reporting

### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

**Companies or organizations expressing their interest are invited to submit documentation of their:**

- Demonstrate good understanding of the Scope for services to be provided.
- Experience/performance in delivering tasks outlined above on a large scale in Uganda, in compliance with national and international standards.
- Experience in engaging project affected persons, communities, and stakeholders in similar infrastructure projects including the needs of vulnerable groups, including women.
- Key suitably qualified and experienced lead personnel in executing the scope.

- Appropriate licensing from relevant in-country authorities for the provision of the services.
- Evidence of a Quality, Health, Safety and Environment Management system, organization, and process in compliance with applicable Local and Industry standards.
- Company details including Certificate of Incorporation, Valid Trading License, Memorandum, and articles of association.
- Registration certificate with the Uganda Revenue Authority (URA) and valid current Tax Clearance Certificate.
- Proof of registration to the National Supplier Database (NSD) maintained by the Petroleum Authority of Uganda.
- Up to date professional licensing from relevant in-country authorities for the provision of the services.
- Compliance to the recommendations of the relevant governing institutions/authorities regarding terms of engagement in survey services.
- Compliance statement of the Local Content Regulations, 2016 and Local Company definition.
- Proof of Anti-corruption, Anti-bribery, Compliance and Human Rights policies.
- Financial capacity to deliver the services required including the submission of audited financial accounts for the last two years.
